

Guided cavern dives in the local cenotes are available for all certified divers to be safely enjoyed. Cenotes are freshwater pools in the jungle that connect to the vast underground cave systems. These pools are the entryway to underwater marvels with visibility well in excess of 45 meters/150 feet, stalactites and stalagmites of every shape and size, and light zones that never cease to amaze.

Cavern dives are guided safely by our professional guides within the light zone and guided cavern standards accepted worldwide. Our cavern guides carry minimum certifications of full cave diver and dive master by a recognized training agency. In many cases, they are cavern or cave diving instructors with hundreds or thousands of dives in the local environment. Maximum allowed ratio of divers to guide is four to one.

Deposit is required upon booking. The fee includes:

- Tanks filled with Air or Nitrox (32%) and O2 for guided CCR diving
- Guiding fees and cenote entrance fees (up to \$25)
- Weights
- Dive Light
- Light lunch, snacks and drinks
- Transport from dive center to dive site (roundtrip)

Equipment rental is available:

- Full Equipment (US \$30/diver/day)
- Equipment (Single Item) (US \$10/diver/day)
